A Letter from the Mayor

Ten years of progress! On December 17, 2012, our first day of cityhood, we were just a municipal boundary and a shared vision to make our community a better place. Look how far we have come!

At that time, police presence was minimal, roads were in decay, parks were neglected and permitting and building inspections were inefficient.

Our friends and neighbors became Brookhaven’s foremothers and forefathers, creating this new city dedicated to a higher standard of quality in the delivery of government services. Everywhere you look, you can see the fruits of our combined labor. Brookhaven is home to a police force that is the envy of the region, the best roads in the state and parks that are getting an infusion of capital improvements and ongoing maintenance never before seen. The city has also worked to ensure resident and business-friendly permitting and inspections, using technology to improve the process and decrease lead times.

Even more exciting and innovative enhancements are on the horizon. We’ll open the new state-of-the-art Public Safety Building on the Peachtree Creek Greenway this fall, and work continues on Park Bond projects in Lynwood and Murphey Candler parks. We have an innovative pilot partnership with UGA underway where we’ll work to purify water around Murphey Candler Lake using a charcoal known as biochar. Our new Arts & Culture Commission has started strong — they have brought “Wings of the City,” a mobile sculpture exhibit by internationally acclaimed Mexican artist Jorge Marin, to locations around the city. We are in the middle of converting our police fleet to all hybrid vehicles to save money and create a more sustainable Brookhaven. Our squadron of police drones is recognized and emulated by law enforcement agencies all over America.

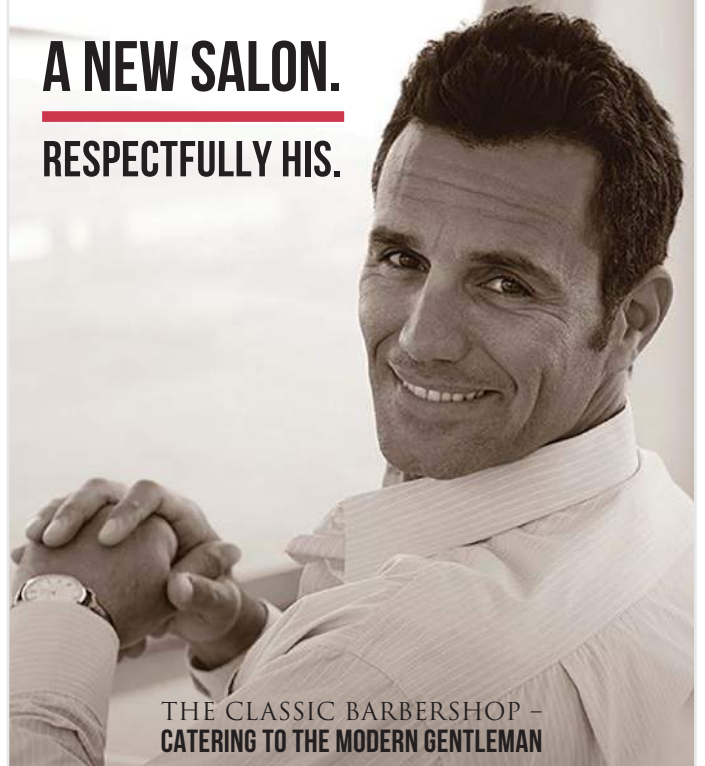

A Big Move

for City Hall

Every city aims to have an accessible, modern city hall from which to serve its community, but the forward-thinking leaders in Brookhaven have taken this vision to new heights with their plans to relocate the Brookhaven City Hall to the Brookhaven/Oglethorpe MARTA station.

The lease-purchase agreement, which both parties approved in June 2022, will allow the city to lease the 1.24-acre property on Peachtree Road for 50 years with an option to purchase after that. A construction timeline was not immediately established, but the

city will be responsible for the project's planning, financing and construction.

Leaders from both parties are excited about the partnership and foresee this transit-focused development resulting in easier access to government services, increased ridership, improved pedestrian and bicycle connectivity and serve as a catalyst for future development around the station.

The 15-acre MARTA station has been at the center of many redevelopment discussions in the past, including previous plans

with the city. While that agreement did not come to fruition, leaders from MARTA and the city have continued discussions over the past five years, which brought this renewed vision to life.

As one of only a handful of city halls in the country located at a rail station, this move solidifies Brookhaven's stance on the importance of transit. City leaders have used phrases such as "pivotal achievement" and "historic milestone" when referring to the project and have touted the long-term, positive outcomes that the new city hall will bring to the community.

More than just a Plaza

The City of Brookhaven is home to over 50,000 people, many of whom are business owners, immigrants and their descendants. One of the most widely-known hubs for communities in the area is Northeast Plaza, a large strip mall that opened in 1957. In its early years, the plaza was home to retailers like Woolworth, Kroger, JCPenney and Zales Jewelers; today, shoppers come to this plaza for the City Farmer's Market, Hibachi Buffet, Fiesta Hair Salon, Happy Land, Pan Paleta and El Mundo De Las Fajas (a women's clothing store).

Over the past four decades, Northeast Plaza has embodied the people who live in proximity and from all over metro Atlanta, resonating with immigrant communities, namely, Latino cultures. Murals line the walls of buildings, including those of Yehimi Cambrón and Michelle Angela Ortiz, that portray reverence for Latino heritage and its people. Beyond anything else, the plaza epitomizes the cultural intermingling and coexistence that makes Buford Highway known for its diversity across the South. Many of the local businesses in this plaza are owned and run by immigrants, built by

dreams from distant homelands and maintained with the hope of carving out a place to prosper. Northeast Plaza has also transformed into a central location for city officials, local advocates, educators, and non-profit organizations to connect with community members who frequent the area in Brookhaven. We Love Buford Highway (WLBH) is one of these partners.

With a mission to preserve the multicultural identity of Atlanta's Buford Highway, the agency hosts community-serving mobile events all along the corridor, many of which have taken place at Northeast

Plaza. In September 2020, they collaborated with other local non-profits to organize a food distribution amidst fears and shutdowns from the pandemic. WLBH staff helped Brookhaven's efforts to ensure that all communities were counted in the 2020 census, providing trust and comfort to people with individual bilingual assistance. The organization celebrated Día De Los Muertos with culturally-centric programming and resources and closed out the year with its annual Holiday Healing event with food distribution, art gifts, an art gallery from local high schools and an appearance by Santa. In 2022, WLBH's executive director, who sits on the Brookhaven Arts and Culture Commission, joined local leaders to present the city-wide proclamation that recognizes this vibrant community of Buford Highway as a Cultural Corridor.

WLBH's programs continuously reiterate the importance of preserving the diverse communities that live, work, and play along Buford Highway. Their work reminds people that behind every small business is an immigrant family that yearns to connect; a reality often overlooked when discussing preservation,



development and advocacy. Through their Story Pillar, the organization has collected testimonies that center around Northeast Plaza's businesses and uniquely sought-after marketplaces.



In honor of last year's Hispanic Heritage Month, WLBH designed a digital story guide campaign to raise awareness of the profound Latino roots and impact immigrants have on Buford Highway's curation. One of the businesses highlighted was Northeast Plaza's La Carreta, a local favorite famous for its traditional Mexican dishes, from enchiladas and chilaquiles to fajitas and molcajetes. Sabores de Buford Highway, sponsored by the Latino Community Fund Georgia, Explore Brookhaven, Doraville and Chamblee, is where journeys from local owners such as La Carreta owner, Cristian Salazar, are collected and shared. Here's an excerpt of the interview:

"I always worked in restaurants as a waiter or cook, and I dreamed of being the owner of my own business. I would come to La Carreta to eat sometimes, and I really liked this place. Five years ago, I was able to buy it. I always miss my mom's food, homemade food. I wanted to have a place like that, where people could eat and feel like they were at home. When I started this business, I would walk everywhere and hand out my flyers and chat with people, inviting them to my restaurant. We can never forget our roots, and we must celebrate them in this country that has given us all many opportunities. We



are going to open a second space for people to be more comfortable. I would like people to continue to be happy here, to see them smiling and coming here with their families. And to continue to value the effort of others. I once was where they are, and they can be where I am now. Being Latino is making a difference in this country. It is being respectful and helping each other. Together, we can achieve everything."

Salazar's perseverance is one of many stories that We Love Buford Highway collects, archives and shares. Places along the corridor, like Northeast Plaza, that are lined with businesses, eateries, professional services and restaurants, are filled with dreams

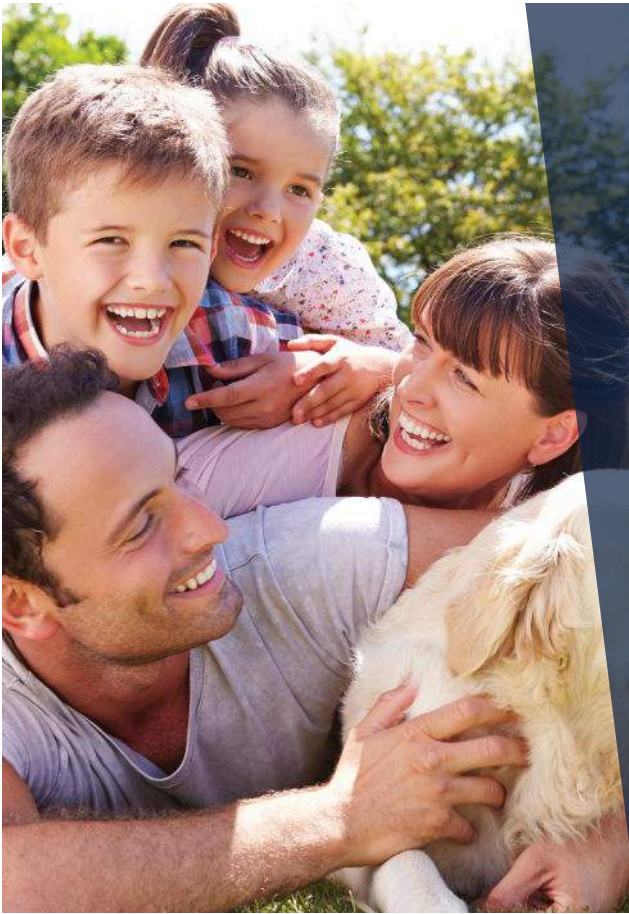
and experiences to be preserved for generations to come and are part of what makes this area of Atlanta so diverse. WLBH believes that success towards its mission of preservation starts with listening to the individual voices that make these vital communities grow.

Northeast Plaza turns 65 this year, a momentous celebration that speaks to the importance that this community center continues to have for those who seek to belong.

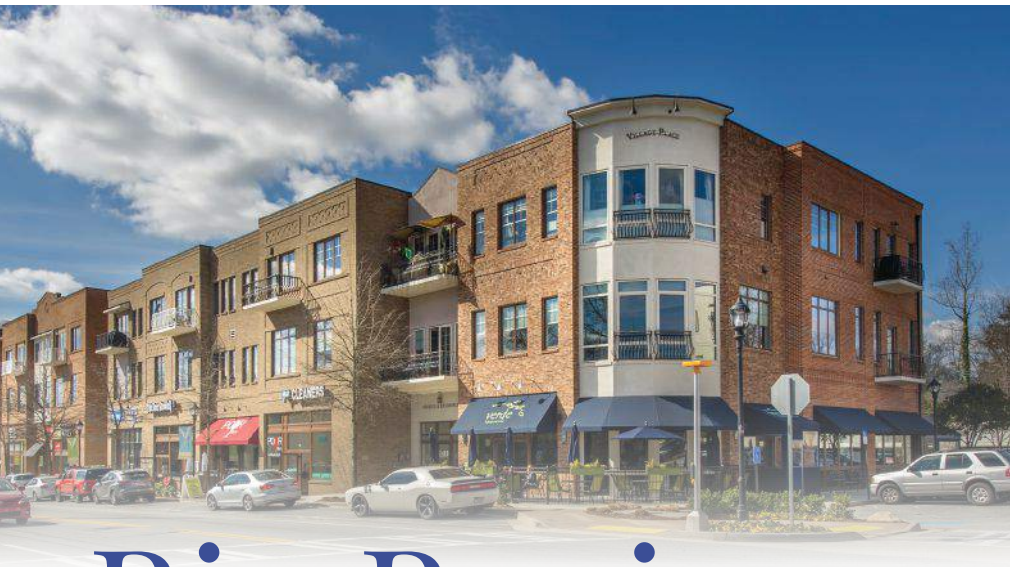

Economic Development



What began over a century ago as a small affluent Atlanta suburban community, Brookhaven has evolved into a thriving, prosperous city known for its abundance of pedestrian-friendly shopping opportunities, diverse ethnic dining destinations and an emerging cultural and arts scene. Incorporated in 2012, it is now DeKalb County's largest city, covering approximately 12 square miles and home to over 55,000 residents. Demographics aside, its biggest assets are the passionate, creative residents working there among the local businesses and community organizations, constantly striving to improve Brookhaven in innovative ways.



Big Business in Brookhaven

Part of Brookhaven lies in Central Perimeter, the geographic heartbeat and workforce center of the Atlanta region. Brookhaven boasts easy access to major highways including I-85, I-285 and Georgia 400, and also has its own MARTA station. With an average age of 34 years old, and 35% of residents holding a 4-year degree, it's no coincidence that companies locating here are able to attract highly-skilled employees and successfully meet their growth and investment goals.

Brookhaven's well-educated professional workforce and diverse population provide an excellent mix of talent and cultural inclusiveness. Notably, Brookhaven is home to Children's Healthcare of Atlanta, a hub for innovative medical care; the Atlanta Hawks official training facility; Oglethorpe University, featuring an acclaimed art museum and the Conant Performing Arts Center; and Emory Healthcare has recently completed construction

on a new 180,000-square-foot musculoskeletal hospital in Executive Park, and will begin construction on an announced additional 1.8M square-feet of mixed-used development.

The city is also the headquarters of most recently Rooms to Go's Atlanta-area offices, and engineering firm Burns & McDonnell. Other City headquarters include AT&T Mobility; Sysnet Global Solutions North American headquarters; The Weather Company World Headquarters; and Carr, Riggs & Ingram, LLC, one of the top 100 accounting firms in the United States.

Brookhaven's stable housing base provides a diverse mix of owner-occupied and rental units attracting a dynamic socio-economic mix of residents. Its vibrant Latin American community provides many unique, locally-owned and operated shops on the south side while Perimeter

Center, on the north side, provides one of metro Atlanta's largest business and shopping districts.

As an officially certified "Tree City," Brookhaven is home to over a dozen premier parks, all undergoing various upgrades thanks to the \$40 million Parks Bond initiative approved by voters in 2018. As the only freestanding pediatric healthcare system in Georgia, Children's Healthcare of Atlanta is the trusted leader in caring for kids. Children's is one of the largest pediatric clinical care providers in the country, managing over one million patient visits annually at three hospitals (Egleston, Hughes Spalding and Scottish Rite), Marcus Autism Center, the Center for Advanced Pediatrics, urgent care centers and neighborhood locations. The not-for-profit organization offers more than 60 pediatric specialties and programs, top healthcare professionals and leading research and technology.

When your child has a minor injury or illness and your family's pediatrician is not available, our Urgent Care Centers are available on evenings, weekends and holidays. Children's at Chamblee-Brookhaven is located at 5080 Peachtree Blvd., Suite 100, Chamblee, GA 30341.

Emory University Hospital

Emory University Hospital was founded in 1904 as Wesley Memorial Hospital, with 50 beds. In 1922, the hospital moved to its current site on Emory University's Clifton Road campus. In 1932, the hospital's name was changed to Emory University Hospital.

Today, Emory University Hospital has 791 licensed beds and employs more than 6,000 physicians and staff. The hospital has 154 ICU beds and a Serious Communicable

Diseases Unit where ongoing research, training and preparedness for challenging infectious diseases continue, since the first patients with Ebola virus disease in the U.S. were treated there in 2014.

The teaching hospital is long known for its services in transplantation, cardiology, cardiac surgery, oncology, neurology/neurosurgery and orthopaedics. Emory University Hospital is a "Magnet" hospital, a designation earned by only 6% of U.S. hospitals for nursing excellence from the American Nurses Credentialing Center. In 2022, for the 11th year in a row, *U.S. News & World Report* ranked Emory University Hospital the No. 1 hospital in both metro Atlanta and Georgia. Also in 2022, Newsweek recognized Emory University Hospital among the top 30 hospitals in the United States and top 150 hospitals in the world. The hospital is part of Emory Healthcare, the most comprehensive academic health system in Georgia.

It expanded in 2011, partnering with Emory Healthcare, the most comprehensive academic health system in Georgia. With a medical staff of more than 750 physicians, Emory Saint Joseph's Hospital offers cancer care and clinical trials as part of the Winship Cancer Institute of Emory University (Georgia's only National Cancer Institute-designated cancer center). Expertise in heart and vascular care earned it the nickname "Atlanta's heart hospital," but Emory Saint Joseph's also houses a host of specialties, including orthopedics, urology and Gamma Knife. In April 2019, the hospital received its sixth consecutive Magnet designation from the American Nurses Credentialing Center, making it the first community hospital and one of only three hospitals in the world to achieve six consecutive Magnet designations. *U.S. News & World Report* has ranked Emory Saint Joseph's Hospital the number two hospital in both Georgia and metro Atlanta for seven consecutive years.

As the only freestanding pediatric healthcare system in Georgia, Children's Healthcare of Atlanta is the trusted leader in caring for kids. The not-for-profit organization's mission is to make kids better today and healthier tomorrow. Children's recently launched its Never Settle: A Campaign for Kids, the largest fundraising campaign in the history of Children's. The campaign will span five years and includes both capital and programmatic support. The demand for pediatric specialty care is greater than ever before and the number of patients Children's treats each year continues to grow. In 2021, Children's managed more than one million patient visits and treated more than 414,000 unique patients from all 159 counties in Georgia. Children's is working at every level to expand reach, improve the patient family experience, support research efforts and transform pediatric healthcare through four main campaign initiatives:

Creating a hospital campus made just for our kids

Children's is committed to providing children and teens the innovative specialty care they deserve. The new hospital will have 20 acres of greenspace, providing several miles of walking trails and garden views for 75% of our patient rooms. We believe patients heal faster and are healthier with access to nature, so we have made greenspace and green views a top priority.

Expanding our resources

Arthur M. Blank Hospital, on the North Druid Hills Campus, will be 19 stories tall with more than 1.5 million square feet of hospital space and 446 beds. Additionally, Children's will continue its commitment to building a pediatric behavioral and mental health system of care that improves outcomes, reduces stigma and enhances access to prevention, diagnosis and treatment.



Continuing our commitment to research and innovation

The North Druid Hills Campus and Arthur M. Blank Hospital will help accelerate our research efforts by creating dedicated space for breakthroughs. This includes a Good Manufacturing Practice (GMP) lab to advance innovative cellular therapies, the Marcus Center for Pediatric Cellular Therapy lab dedicated to innovative care and the use of 3D printing to design lifesaving treatment options.

Training the next generation of doctors and providers

Strongly aligned with Emory University School of Medicine, Morehouse School of Medicine and Georgia Institute of Technology, Children's is uniquely positioned to serve as a national and global leader in taking on pediatric care's greatest challenges. Arthur M. Blank Hospital will provide two times more conference and simulation space to help more than 400 fellows and residents contribute to groundbreaking work.

Arthur M. Blank Hospital

One of the most visible components of the campaign is the construction of the new, 19-story Arthur M. Blank Hospital. This project is made possible through a generous \$200 million donation from The Arthur M. Blank Family Foundation, the largest donation in Children's history.

Expected to open in 2025, Children's broke ground on Arthur M. Blank Hospital in 2020. The new hospital will improve quality of care, patient experience and access to specialized pediatric healthcare for Georgia's children and families. Arthur M. Blank Hospital will exist to serve a diverse population of kids, from all economic backgrounds, and it will be an important part of our state's pediatric healthcare network. Arthur M. Blank Hospital will focus on cardiac, hematology/oncology and transplant services. Children's Healthcare of Atlanta Heart Center, ranked in the top 5 in the U.S. for Cardiac Intensive Care Unit (CICU) volumes, surgical procedures and catheterization procedures, will have expanded resources and capabilities at the new hospital to provide even better care for our cardiac patients. The Aflac Cancer and Blood Disorders Center – which cares for more kids with cancer than anyone in the state of Georgia – will consolidate all inpatient services at the new hospital, representing more than 20 percent of the total hospital beds. The consolidation will substantially reduce travel burdens on patient families for treatment and follow-up appointments. Arthur M. Blank Hospital will seek designation as a dedicated Level 1 pediatric trauma center, the only one in Georgia. Children's Healthcare of Atlanta Scottish Rite Hospital will remain a Level 2 pediatric trauma



center and grow its neuroscience and orthopedic programs, while Children's Healthcare of Atlanta Hughes Spalding Hospital will remain focused on providing primary care and treating sickle cell disease and asthma. The hospital will have larger single-patient rooms, meeting modern standards of care for pediatric hospitals, and will allow for families to stay overnight more comfortably with their children. Other key amenities across the hospital, including family kitchens, business centers, shower facilities and laundry rooms, will help to normalize a family's routine as much as possible. Playgrounds, playrooms, libraries and school-support spaces allow for kids to feel like kids. Attached to the hospital will be an 11-story, 325,000-square-foot medical office building that will house outpatient clinics, a high-tech simulation center and medical conference space. This proximity to the hospital will allow physicians to move quickly between inpatient, clinical and administrative responsibilities.

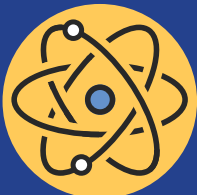

Oglethorpe University was founded in 1835 in Midway, Georgia, but later reestablished in 1915 at the end of Atlanta's trolley line—now the City of Brookhaven. Today, Oglethorpe's historic campus, featuring signature collegiate Gothic revival architecture, is a prominent landmark in Brookhaven.

Top-notch academics.

A co-educational private liberal arts college, Oglethorpe University is home to 1450 diverse and engaged undergraduate students from more than 30 states and 30 countries.

Consistently ranked among top colleges, Oglethorpe's academically rigorous programs emphasize intellectual curiosity, individual attention, close collaboration among faculty and students, and active

learning in relevant field experiences and professional development. Oglethorpe offers 60+ majors and minors, and for students who want to forge their own path of study, an individually planned major. The most popular majors include biology, business, communications, psychology, and physics-engineering, with 60% of students in business or STEM fields. Oglethorpe's Adult Degree Program is tailored to working adults seeking to earn their college degree.

Oglethorpe also offers academic programs that might surprise you—like astrophysics, medical and scientific illustration, environmental studies, international business, African American studies, film production, and a public health concentration.

An inclusive, supportive community.

Under the leadership of President Nicholas Ladany, Oglethorpe is deeply committed to its students and prioritizes their success and well-being through a supportive and inclusive environment.

A new Center for Student Success anchors Oglethorpe's commitment to providing holistic and developmental student support services and programs in an integrative environment. Expanded mental health services include hybrid in-person and virtual counseling that allows students to access care 24/7.

Oglethorpe embraces diversity, equity and inclusion as an institutional core value and fosters

a campus environment that encourages a culture of respect and values diverse experiences and perspectives. Indeed, Oglethorpe's student body is remarkably diverse: nearly 60% identify as persons of color; more than a third are the first generation in their family to attend college; and more than a third are Pell-eligible.

Too expensive? Think again.

At Oglethorpe, 99% of students receive financial need-based aid. Since 2017, the Fiske Guide to Colleges has named Oglethorpe to its list of just 20 "Best Buy Schools" in the nation, which evaluates quality, cost, and value.

In addition to academic and need-based scholarships, OU offers Flagship 50®, a groundbreaking merit tuition scholarship program that matches all 50 states' flagship tuition for qualified students. Oglethorpe also doubles Georgia's Hope Scholarships and other states' equivalents.

Leading through innovation.

The university has flourished in recent years with unprecedented growth in enrollment, philanthropic giving, and innovative partnerships. The campus has expanded to include an award-winning campus center, a 374-unit residential complex, expanded arts and athletics facilities, and most recently, an ADA-friendly woodland walk and the I.W. "Ike" Cousins Center for Science and Innovation.

In 2019, Oglethorpe opened the Q. William Hammack, Jr. School of Business after a transformational \$50 million gift commitment from alumnus Bill Hammack. The



donation was the largest in the university's history and the largest-ever to a liberal arts university to establish a school of business. Mr. Hammack retired as President and CEO of C. W. Matthews Contracting Company, Inc.—a career he began while still an Oglethorpe business student.

The Hammack School, which boasts a near 100% career and graduate school placement rate, has continued to grow, adding new majors and programs, including business analytics, case competitions, and an idea incubator for budding entrepreneurs to compete for seed money.

In 2022, Oglethorpe announced the addition of an Innovation and Entrepreneurship Center, currently in development under the leadership of founding director Dr. Leroy Carson. As part of the Hammack School, the Center will serve OU students as well as metro Atlanta entrepreneurs. The Center's Atlanta Entrepreneurship Lab, slated to open in spring 2023, will map the metro area's entrepreneurial ecosystem to provide one of the city's principal resources for future and current entrepreneurs.

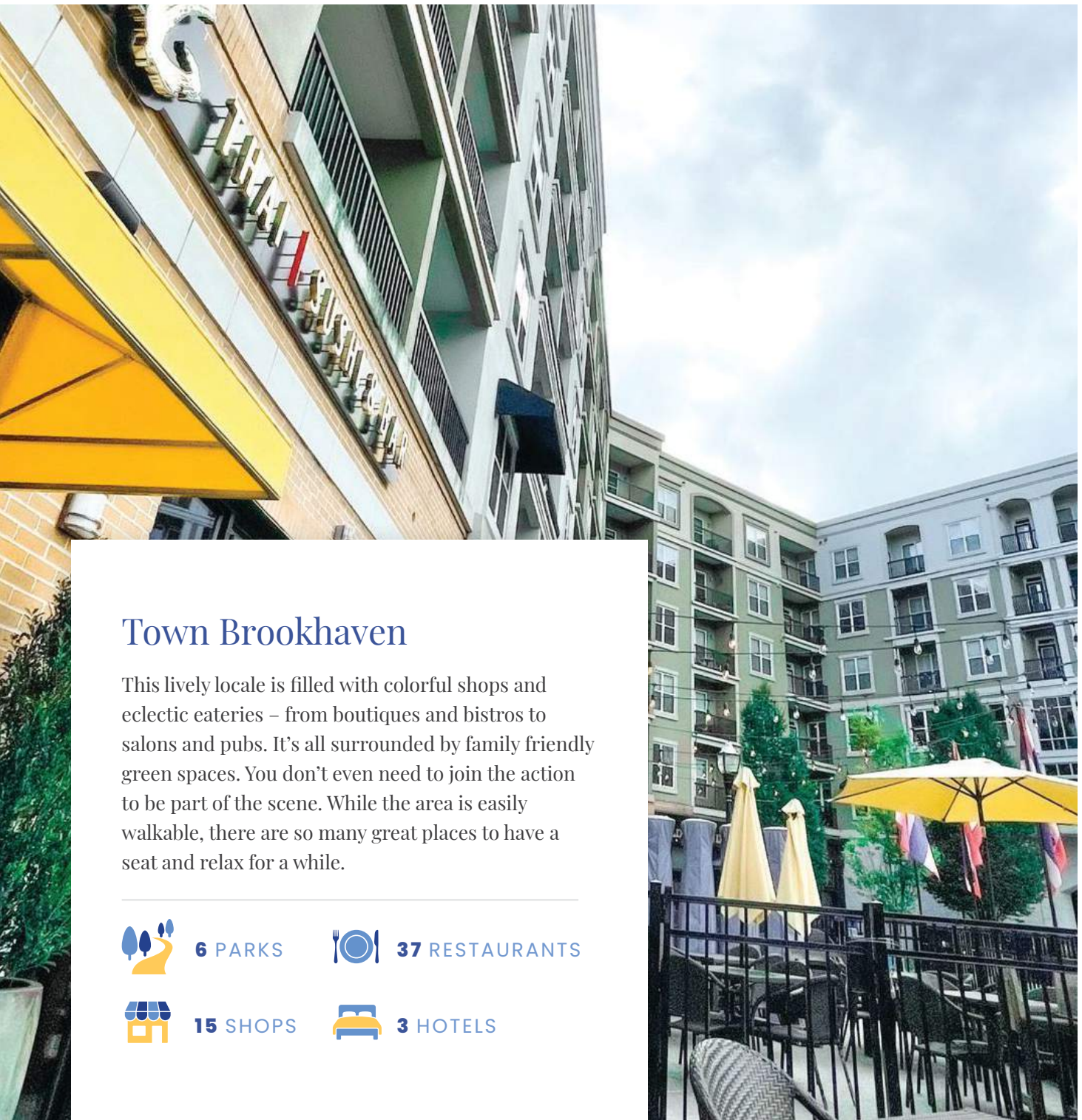

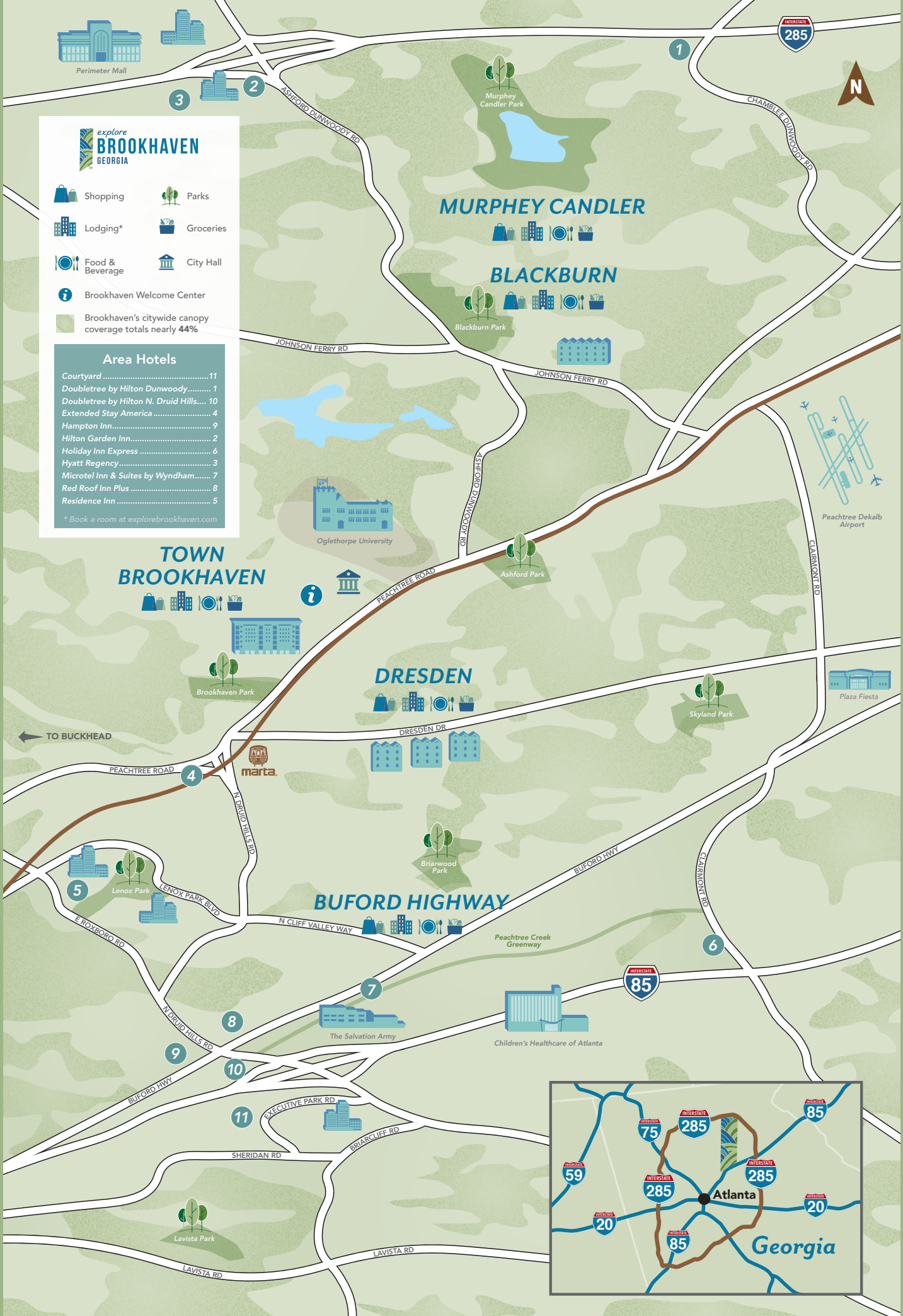
